RULES FOR REGISTRATION

The Bluefaced Leicester Union of North America (herein after called BLU) was formed as the North American Registry for Bluefaced Leicester sheep (herein called BFL) so that their pedigrees could be recorded. Associated Sheep Registries (herein called ASR) was hired to maintain this registry.

SO THAT this registry may retain its integrity and purpose, the following rules are now standing:

1. Only purebred Bluefaced Leicesters may be registered.
2. Select a name for your *Prefix* if you haven't already. A Prefix is attached to the animal's ID and registration, and identifies the farm and/or the breeder. Traditionally, the name of the farm is used, but some people choose to use their surname, or some other name. Maximum 25 characters including spaces for Prefixes.
3. Print the *name* of the animal (if it has one) exactly as it should appear on the registration. There is a maximum of 30 characters allowed for the sheep name, including spaces. PLEASE NOTE: The *sheep name* is not the same as the *Prefix*.
4. BLU is no longer using the separate designation 'AI' after the sheep name. 'UK' after the sheep name will still be used to designate a UK-bred animal.
5. Both white and natural colored purebred lambs are eligible for registration.
6. When registering a natural colored lamb, the color at birth must be designated in the COLOR column on the application form with two (2) letters:

First Letter Designation:

B = Black, or

M = Brown (or Moorit). A completely brown animal, no black hairs anywhere.

Second Letter Designation:

P = Pattern ('English blue', 'silver saddle', 'badger face,' etc.), or

S = Solid

Clarification:

This Registry wants to know: What color is the lamb *at birth*?

- a. If the lamb is white: The COLOR column will be left blank (no letter designation).
- b. If the lamb is other than white: Is it black ("B"), or brown (Moorit) ("M")?
- c. If the lamb is black: Does it have white markings on its face or ears, or a lighter color across the top of its back and sides ('English blue,' 'badger face,' 'silver saddle,' etc.)? If yes, the second letter of the designation in the color column is "P" ("Pattern"); if no, the second letter will be "S" ("Solid").
- d. If the lamb is brown (Moorit): The first letter of the designation is "M", followed by either the "P" or "S" as the second letter (as described above in paragraph c.)

These color designation letters will appear in the registration number, e.g., "1623BP"; and will become a permanent part of the BLU registration number for that individual animal only. **It will NOT be automatically carried down to succeeding generations' registration numbers.** Black Pattern (BP) is currently the most common natural coloration we see in North America, but that's not to say that we will not see Black Solid (BS), or Moorit (MP or MS) in the future.

7. Any ram semen being used for artificial insemination or embryo transfer, must have a proper BLU registration number in order for the resulting offspring to be registered by BLU. This includes domestic or imported semen. Additionally, for imported semen you will need:
 - a. a copy of the USDA import permit, and
 - b. a signed statement of pedigree by the semen donor ram's owner.

8. All applications being presented for registration of lambs that were bred through artificial insemination or embryo transfer, either with imported semen or domestic semen, must be accompanied by BLU's ***Certificate of Artificial Insemination Breeding***, properly completed and signed by the appropriate personnel.
9. All applications for lambs sired by a ram NOT owned by the owner of the dam at the time of lambing must be accompanied by BLU's ***Certificate of Breeding*** as part of required documentation when registering sheep under the following circumstances:
 - a. For use when applicant is not the breeder of offspring being registered, or owner of the sire per BLU's records.
 - b. When bred ewes (dam) are purchased, or a ram (sire) is leased/borrowed.
10. All lambs must be registered by December 31 *in the year of their birth*:
 - a. \$5.00 registration fee per sheep; BLU Members and BLU Junior Members
 - b. \$10.00 registration fee per sheep; Associate Members and Non-BLU Members,
11. Late Registrations. Any lamb (or sheep) registered after the deadline:
 - a. \$10.00 late registration fee per sheep; BLU Members and BLU Junior Members
 - b. \$20.00 late registration fee per sheep; Associate Members and Non-BLU Members
12. Imported Ram Semen Fee. To assign a BLU registration number to an imported ram, and to include the Sire and Dam of the ram being registered:
 - a. \$5.00 per ram; BLU Members and BLU Junior Members
 - b. \$10.00 per ram; Associate Members and Non-BLU Members
 - c. If a more extensive pedigree is wanted on an imported ram, the Extended Pedigree will be provided for \$10.00 in addition to the initial \$5.00/\$10.00 fee.
13. To register and transfer an animal at the same time, both the registration *and* the transfer fee must be paid.
14. Extended Pedigrees may be entered for an additional fee of \$10.00.
15. All documents mentioned herein are legal documents. They must be truthfully completed and signed appropriately.
16. BLU reserves the right to amend, add to, and/or delete from the above rules and regulations.

To Register and Transfer sheep at the same time you will need:

1. Rules for Registration – BLU requirements for registration

4. Application for Registration form

Please note: Both the registration fee and the transfer fee must be paid at the same time.

To Register sheep born of a sire that you did not own (borrowed or leased ram) you will need:

1. Rules for Registration – BLU requirements for registration
2. Work Order
3. Certificate of Breeding form
4. Application for Registration form

To Register sheep born from artificial insemination you will need:

1. Rules for Registration – BLU requirements for registration
2. Work Order
3. Certificate of Artificial Insemination Breeding
4. Application for Registration form

To register ram semen imported from another country you will need:

1. Rules for Registration – BLU requirements for registration
2. Work Order
3. Imported Semen Registration Form
4. Importation papers for semen (original copy of USDA Form 17-135)

Clarification:

Work Order - Must accompany all work sent to ASR.

Application for Registration - Form to enter the information on sheep you wish to register. Refer to *Rules for Registration* before completing.

Certificate of Breeding - Must accompany registration form when you are registering sheep sired by a ram that you did not own at the time of breeding.

Certificate of Artificial Insemination Breeding - Certification that all artificial insemination procedures (including embryo transplant) are done in full compliance with USDA rules, and affidavit of technician doing the work.

Imported Semen Registration Form - Ram semen from another country, used to breed BFL ewes in the BLU Registry, must be registered with a ram name and affidavit of proper USDA protocols being met for that importation, in order to register lambs born of that semen.

A BRIEF HISTORY OF THE BLUEFACED LEICESTER

Also known as: Hexham Leicester

Descendents of Robert Bakewell's improved Dishley Leicester, the Bluefaced Leicester evolved near Hexham in Northumberland, England, in the early 1900s. Classified as a longwool type, it is one of three Leicester sheep breeds; English (or Longwool) Leicester, Border Leicester, and Bluefaced Leicester. It has the finest fleece of the Leicester breeds, and the softest fleece of all the Longwool breeds.

The Bluefaced Leicester was originally created to produce high-quality crossbred ewes from the native Blackface and Swaledale draft ewes. It was found that a darker skinned ram, with a finer wool produced a better crossbred ewe from the Blackfaced hill ewes, a cross traditionally called the "Mule." From its original home in the Northern Pennines, the breed spread throughout England, Scotland, and Wales, and into Northern Ireland. It eventually replaced the Teeswater breed as the "premier crossing sire;" at one time the Bluefaced Leicester was called "The Great Improver." Dedicated breeders in the United Kingdom eventually came together and organized The Bluefaced Leicester Sheep Breeders' Association. They published their first national flock book in 1964, beginning with sheep registered in 1963.

In the early 1970s, two separate shipments of Bluefaced Leicesters were imported into Canada from the United Kingdom. To date, it is accepted knowledge that these two shipments were the original importations of the breed into North America. A number of years later, during the 1980s, Bluefaced Leicesters arrived in the United States from Nova Scotia. The first preservation efforts began in 1995, when a few breeders in the United States purchased and divided two North American flocks, one from Nova Scotia, the other from Virginia. Sheep from the two flocks were cross-bred until new genetics could be obtained.

Growing concern for the breed led to the importation of frozen semen from the United Kingdom to expand the genetic base of the Bluefaced Leicester in the US. In 1997, the first "new blood" since the original importations was introduced into North America.

Following this important milestone, the Bluefaced Leicester Union of North America (BLU) was organized in 1998 to educate, preserve and promote the breed, and support its members. BLU established an official Registry with the 1998 lamb crop. In early 2004, a second association was formed, the Bluefaced Leicester Breeders' Association (BFLBA), with its primary focus of education, breed preservation, and promotion.

With renewed interest in this magnificent breed, the past decade has seen much positive growth. From a mere handful of sheep, flocks have expanded across the country, there have been more UK sires collected and imported, and there is an increasing number of registrations from coast to coast. The Bluefaced Leicester is certainly proving itself as a multi-purpose breed; ideal for the purebred sheep breeder and enthusiast, the hand-spinner and fiber artist, and the commercial producer.

2006 was witness to a new milestone for the breed in the United States; the publication of the first national flock book by the Bluefaced Leicester Union of North America, beginning with sheep registered in 2005.

2007 also proved to be a very important year for the Bluefaced Leicester in the U.S.; the first-ever National Bluefaced Leicester Show was held in conjunction with the New York State Sheep & Wool Festival, in Rhinebeck, NY, in October. It was also the 2007 Featured Breed at the Festival. The combination of a nationally-recognized Sheep & Wool Festival, National BFL Show, and Featured Breed display was invaluable... not only for bringing together BFL breeders and enthusiasts from across North America, but also in bringing the breed further into the public awareness. Also of major importance, several U.S. breeders exported Bluefaced Leicesters to Canada in the summer and fall of 2007, with the first landing in Nova Scotia in July. It was generally considered "the return of the Bluefaced Leicester to Canada" after an alleged absence of the breed from the country since the mid-1990s.

BREED GUIDELINE FOR THE BLUEFACED LEICESTER

A General Description of The Breed

HEAD

The Bluefaced Leicester should have a broad muzzle, a good mouth (no overshot or undershot mouth), a Roman nose, bright alert eyes, and long erect ears.

On a white animal, the color of the head skin should be dark blue showing through white hair, with no wool on the head or cheeks. Wool may grow right up to the throat area, especially in winter. Both sexes are polled.

BODY, HINDQUARTERS & LEGS

There should be a good length of neck laid into broad shoulders, and a good “spring of rib” with no tendency towards “slab-sidedness.” The chest should be deep and wide, and there should be no tendency towards a “pinched girth” (or extremely narrow heart girth area).

The Bluefaced Leicester is known for its long strong back; it should be level with no weakness (dips or a rough join) behind the shoulder. Despite the length of the back, there should be no tendency for the back to sag (or “sway”), especially in a younger animal. The shoulders should be broad, and well-rounded.

The hips should be level and wide, with broad and deep thighs. Overall, the hindquarters should be deep with good angles from the hip to the hock. Extremely shallow/narrow hindquarters, and extremely straight rear leg angles (or “post legs”) should be avoided.

The legs should be clean, well-positioned, and strong-boned. Good leg placement and angles also promote smooth and correct movement. Leg joints should appear smooth, with no tendency towards coarseness (or “knobby” joints). The belly and the legs below the hock should be free of wool. There should be black hooves and no evidence of low (“soft” or sagging) pasterns.

Rams: Testicles should be free of wool, well-developed, and hang down a distance from the body.

Ewes: Udders should be free of wool, and show evidence of two good teats. In addition, if there is udder development, it should be “tight” (meaning not grossly large, or pendulous; well-attached), well-formed, and balanced.

Again, the mature Bluefaced Leicester will carry no wool on its head/cheeks, belly, legs, scrotal/vaginal, and udder areas.

OVERALL APPEARANCE OR DEMEANOR

The overall appearance is of an alert animal with a bold carriage, purposeful stride, and commanding presence. Rams have a proud bearing and masculine look, and the ewes exhibit a feminine look. The general appearance should be one of fitness and vigor, as this is a very athletic breed of sheep.

COLOR

All purebred Bluefaced Leicester sheep are permitted in the Registry regardless of color: white, or black patterned; and at some point, black solid, or brown (Moorit). (Please refer to the Rules for Registration, Section 4.)

Natural Colored: Although the Bluefaced Leicester is predominately a white wool breed, it does carry a recessive black gene and natural colored lambs do appear.

Natural colored Bluefaced Leicesters can range from almost solid, to dark animals with patterning (lighter areas of hair and/or wool) on the face, legs, saddle, and other areas. There should be no distinct white spots in the wool, on the body.

White: On white individuals with dark blue skin, the blue coloration is also noticeable on the body skin itself (underneath the wool) and on the upper parts of the legs, as well as on the head and neck skin.

On a white animal, small black spots are permissible on the face, ears, neck, and legs. Lips and nostrils are preferably black, but mottled grey is acceptable. There should be no distinct black or brown spots in the wool, on the body.

There should be no rust-colored or red-brown hairs or spots/speckles anywhere on the legs or head.

WOOL

On both white and natural colored Bluefaced Leicesters, the wool should be tightly curled, fine, dense, semi-lustrous, and when parted, it should open cleanly to the skin. There should be an even, consistent fleece coverage on the body, and the fleece should be free of hair and kemp. There should be no tendency for the main body of fleece to “peel” (the fleece breaking and sloughing off).

The Bluefaced Leicester is classified as a longwool breed with a staple length of 3-6 inches, a fleece weight of 2½-4½ lbs., and a fiber diameter of 56s-60s count, or 24-28 microns. It creates high-quality semi-lustre yarns with beautiful drape.

SIZE

The adult Bluefaced Leicester has one of the largest body weights of the British breeds. In spite of this size, when mated to the smaller hill-type ewe, the ewe is able to carry and lamb its crossbred progeny without the slightest difficulty. A ram at maturity should weigh 200-250 lbs., with some individuals reaching 300 lbs. Rams have an excellent disposition and are quite manageable despite their size. Ewes will usually weigh 150-175 lbs. at maturity, with some individuals topping 200 lbs.

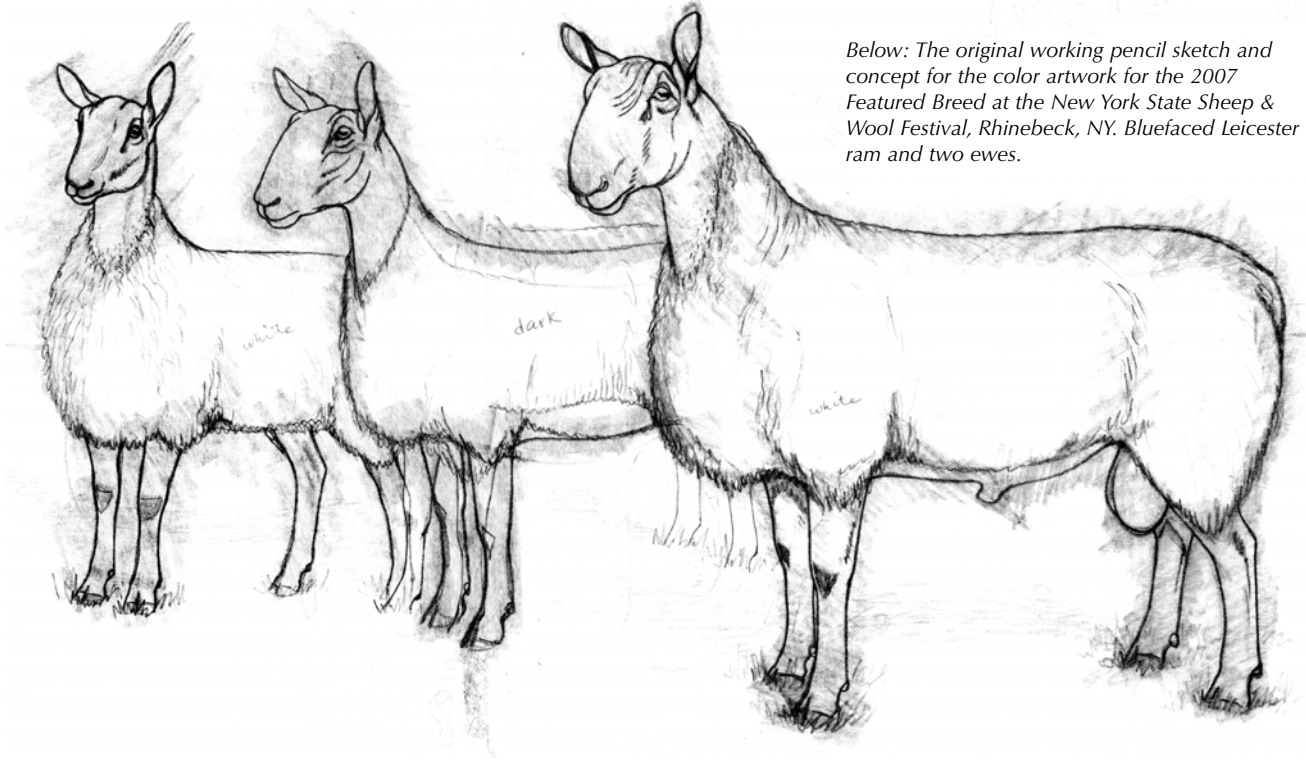
LAMBING PERCENTAGE

The Bluefaced Leicester is the most prolific of all the native British breeds. It is common for registered flocks to achieve lamb crops of 200% to 250%. The ewe has the milking ability to support these multiple births.

FINAL NOTES

Although this breed *originally* descended from similar stock, today's Bluefaced Leicester should not look like a Border Leicester. There are many unique and distinctive characteristics that separate this breed from the Border Leicester breed.

Also, it is important to note that the breed guideline here is referring to the “Traditional” or “Classic” Bluefaced Leicester (in white), not the “Crossing Type” Bluefaced Leicester. The “Crossing Type” BFL took a foothold in the UK during the late 1990s through the turn of the new century, and it currently has a strong following among many breeders. Some UK breeders have both types on their farms and keep the flocks separate. The “Crossing Type” is typically recognized by its bold patterns of spots and speckles in dark brown, rust brown, and/or dark grey on the head and legs (it is also a white sheep). The “Crossing Type” also appears to have a slightly different shaped head (somewhat more domed at the top of the head) and ear placement than the “Traditional.”

BLUEFACED LEICESTER UNION OF NORTH AMERICA SCORECARD

A Guideline for Judging Bluefaced Leicester Sheep

Applies to both White and Natural Colored Animals - "Traditional" type BFLs

GENERAL APPEARANCE (10 Points)

Overall appearance is a proud animal with a bold carriage, purposeful stride and commanding presence. Rams to appear masculine and ewes to appear feminine.

CONDITION (10 Points)

Animals should be in working condition, well-muscled and not overly fat or thin; this is a very athletic breed of sheep.

HEAD & NECK (10 Points)

HEAD: Broad muzzle, good mouth, Roman nose, alert eyes, long erect ears. Black nose and lips (dark mottled gray acceptable). No red-brown spots/speckles. On a white animal the head skin should be dark blue showing through white hair. Small black spots are permissible on the face, ears, and neck. Both sexes polled.

NECK: Good length, laid into broad shoulders.

FOREQUARTERS (5 Points)

SHOULDERS: Broad shoulders, well rounded.

LEGS: Straight, wide apart, strong-boned, free of wool. Black hooves, and no evidence of low pasterns. No rust-colored hairs, or red-brown spots/speckles. Small black spots are permissible on the legs.

BODY (15 Points)

CHEST: Deep and wide.

RIBS: Well-sprung; "a good spring of rib." No extremely narrow heart girth area ("pinched girth").

BACK: Long, strong and level. No weakness behind the shoulder.

WOOL COVER: Even, consistent fleece on the body. Free of wool on the head, neck, legs, belly.

HINDQUARTERS (10 Points)

Hindquarters should be 1/3 or less in proportion. No extremely straight hindquarter angles from the hip through the hock ("post legged").

HIPS: Level, smooth, and wide apart.

THIGHS: Broad and deep.

LEGS: Well-positioned, strong-boned, clean, and free of wool below hock. Black hooves, and no evidence of low pasterns. No rust-colored hairs, or red-brown spots/speckles. Small black spots are permissible on the legs.

UDDER & SCROTUM: RAMS – Testicles free of wool, well-developed, and hanging down a distance from the body. EWES – Udders free of wool, and showing evidence of two good teats.

WOOL (40 Points)

1. Tightly curled, fine, and dense. When parted, it opens cleanly to the skin.
2. Semi-lustrous, 56s-60s count, 24-28 microns, staple 3-6 inches long.
3. Free of kemp and hair.
4. Uniform fleece.
5. No black spots in white wool, no white spots in black wool, on the body. Small black spots are permissible on the face, ears, neck, and legs.

FAULTS

Structural Faults

Overshot or undershot mouth

Weakness behind the shoulder (dips or rough join)

Lack of good spring of the rib cage ("slab-sided")

Extremely narrow heart girth area ("pinched girth")

Sway back

Weakness in the pasterns (low or "soft" pasterns)

Extremely straight hindquarter angles from the hip through the hock ("post legged")

Color Faults

Rust-colored hairs, or red-brown spots or speckles anywhere on the head, legs, or in the wool on the body (on white sheep)

Distinctive black spots in white wool on the body

Distinctive white spots in black wool on the body

Wool Cover Faults

Wool cover where there should be none

"Peeling" of the main body of fleece

INTERPRETATION OF FLOCK BOOK ENTRIES

1. Each person registering or transferring in the BLU Registry will have a flock number and prefix assigned.
2. This flock number and prefix will follow all transactions.
3. Each animal will have a registration number permanently assigned to it.
4. Each time either of these numbers is used, the corresponding information will come up.

Interpretation of Example:

555 = Flock Number assigned by the BLU Registry (Note: 101 is the flock number of the US farm who imported straws of this particular UK ram).

05-1889 = birth year + animal registration number assigned by BLU.

The ram lambs were sired by two different rams; the individual ram lambs are listed under their respective sires.

The registration numbers assigned to the ram lambs are: 1889, 1890, 1891, and 1892. This breeder registered three ewe lambs sired by the Beeston ram and born in 2005. The registration numbers assigned to the ewe lambs are: 1893, 1894BP, and 1895.

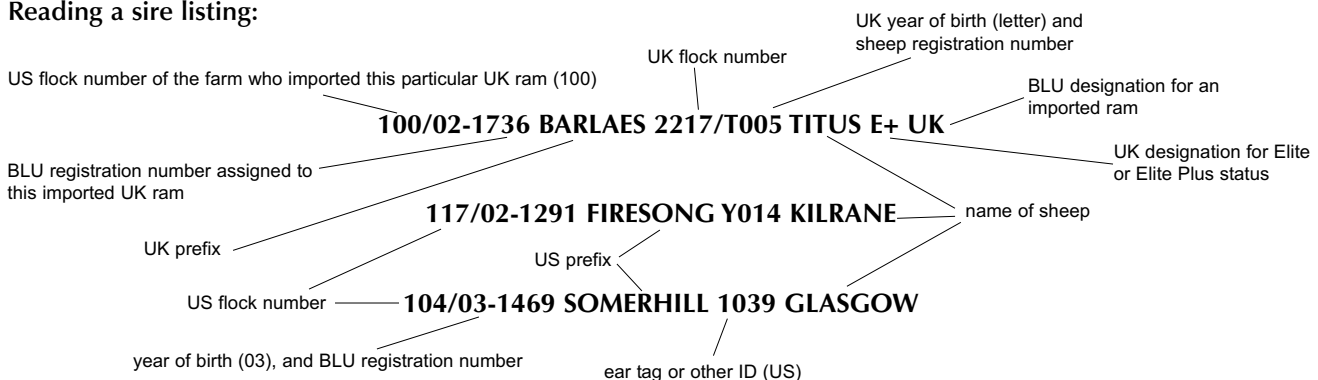
